Transforming Transportation on the Southside

POTENTIAL UPDATES TO FOUR EXISTING BUS ROUTES

B (Big Bend) will travel on Meridian Road and Monroe Street in both directions between C.K. Steele Plaza and the Southside Transit Center. South of Orange Avenue, Big Bend will travel south on Crawfordville Road to Capital Circle, then head north on Woodville Highway, and use Ross Road to return to Crawfordville Road. Riders who previously used Big Bend stops on Woodville Highway north of Ross Road can use the Southside Flex.

L (Live Oak) will travel in and out of the Southside Transit Center and out and back along Jim Lee and Paul Russell Road for two-way service at Rickards High School. Otherwise, the route is unchanged.

G (Gulf) will still travel from C.K. Steele Plaza to Paul Russell Road but will now provide access to the Governor's Square Mall. G (Gulf) will not continue on Ridge Road; instead, riders can now use the new Circulator route to travel from Ridge Road to other places in Southside, the Southside Transit Center, or connect to other StarMetro bus routes.

M (Moss) will travel on Orange Avenue directly to the Southside Transit Center. Service to South Monroe Commons on Paul Russell Road will be available on B (Big Bend), G (Gulf), and the new Circulator.

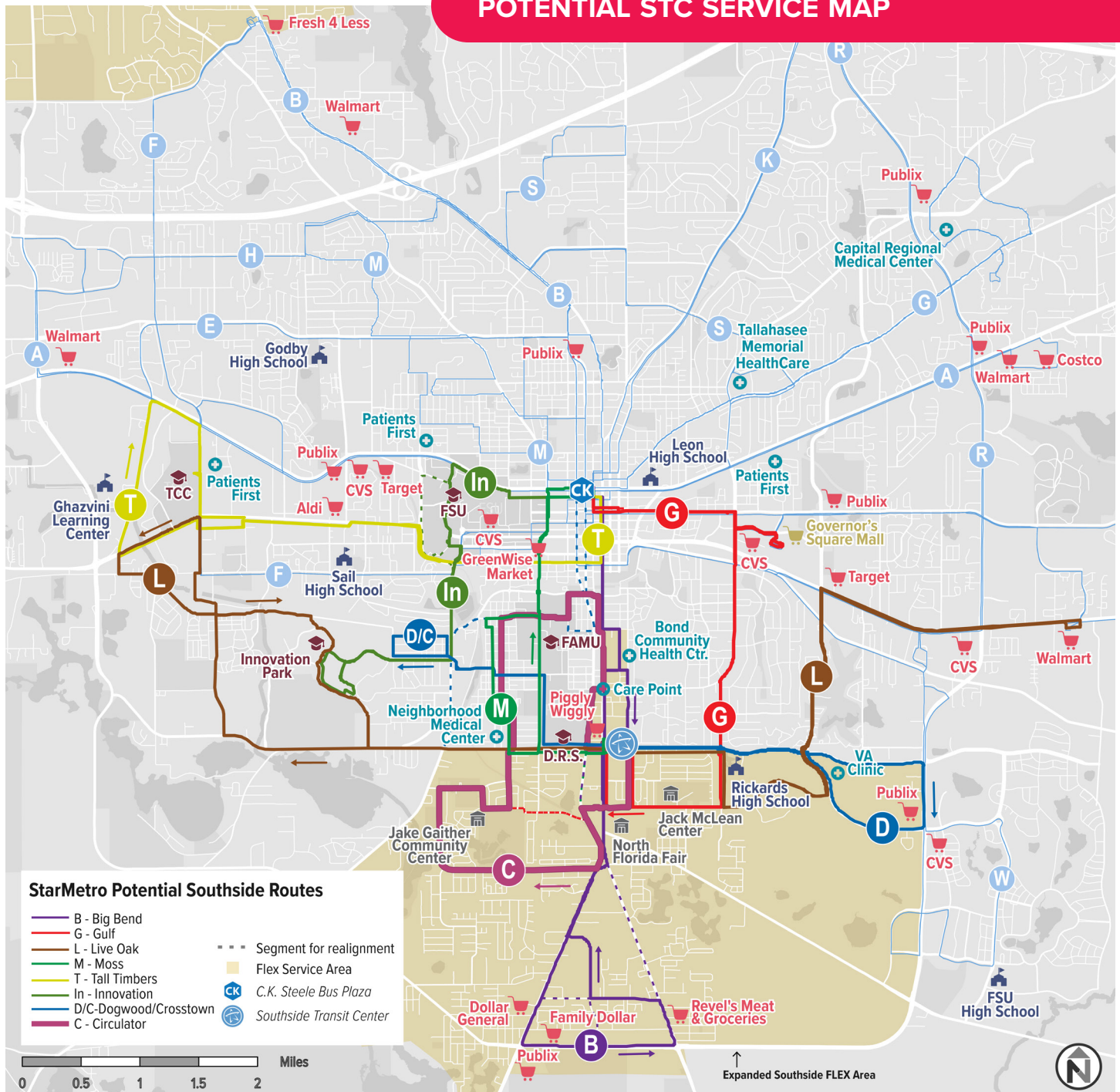

TWO NEW BUS ROUTES CONSIDERED

A new **Circulator Route** would travel through Southside neighborhoods serving the Jake Gaither Center, the Bond neighborhood (Saxon Street), FAMU, the Southside Transit Center, and more.

The new **Dogwood/Crosstown Route** would connect the Providence neighborhood (Levy & McCaskill Avenues) with FAMU, Orange Avenue, the VA Hospital, Capital Circle & Blair Stone Road, and more. The Providence neighborhood will still have access to C.K. Steele Plaza via the FSU Innovation Route.

YOUR GROCERY CONNECTION!

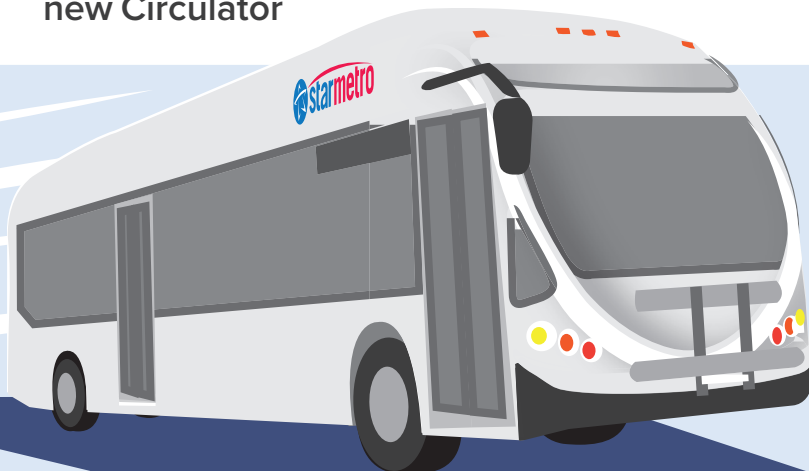
Potential direct connections to six grocery stores from the **STC**.
